On **January 15, 2010**, as Tidewater Community College marks the anniversary of the birth of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr., the college will present the Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Scholarship to one Tidewater Community College student. This scholarship seeks to recognize an individual who best exemplifies the teachings and example of Dr. King; advocates a nonviolent approach to solving society's problems; fosters positive race relations in our community; strives to remove the social, political, and economic barriers of inequality; and possesses a realistic optimism, based on faith, of a better future for all Americans.

To be eligible for this scholarship, the student must:

- > Be currently enrolled at Tidewater Community College
- > Have at least one semester remaining prior to graduation from TCC
- > Be in good academic standing, with a 2.5 or higher GPA
- > Have completed at least 12 credit hours at TCC
- > Provide evidence of community service or service learning experience (continuous committed service in the community)
- > Submit a completed application by the due date
