**RAD 196-On-Site Training**

The Program application deadline is July 1 for the class that begins Fall Semester in August. Apply to the College at [www.tcc.edu](http://www.tcc.edu) and submit the CT Program application to Ellyn Hodgis (address is on the application). Students must be **registered radiographers** with the ability perform patient care skills in a professional manner.

Enrollment will be for 2 consecutive semesters. The 3 credit fall class will meet on Tuesday evenings from 6 PM to 8:50 PM and the 2 credit spring class will meet on Tuesdays from 6 PM to 7:50 PM 2 hours.

RAD 196 On Site Training, a 2 credit clinical course is incorporated to provide clinical experience in one of the radiography program's clinical affiliates when approved on an individual basis by the CT director. The clinical component requires 10-15 hours per week. The clinical rotation should be agreed upon between the student and the clinical supervisor prior to the application deadline of July 1st. The college has the right to limit the number of students rotating at any one site. Admission to the program is limited by the number of clinical sites, and will be determined on a first come, first serve basis of qualified applicants. Priority is granted to Virginia residents who reside in the political subdivisions supporting the college.

Students who successfully complete RAD 242, 247 and RAD 196 and all of the ARRT clinical requirements will be qualified to apply to the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists (ARRT) to take the CT certification exam. RAD 196 may be repeated in the Spring semester to continue working on the ARRT requirements in the clinical site, as long as satisfactory clinical progress is documented in the initial semester.

Prospective students are hereby notified that the medical facilities may require immunization records, criminal/sex offender background checks as well as drug screens prior to being authorized to attend clinical. The cost of these tests is the responsibility of the student.

## Registration Process

1. Submit an application to the college if you are not already a TCC student. You may do this online, or in person at the admissions office at any TCC campus. Visit [www.tcc.edu/students/admissions](http://www.tcc.edu/students/admissions). You do not need to take placement tests or meet with a counselor.

*Important*-when answering questions on the application: check credit classes, answer no to pursuing a degree, and check upgrading job skills as your reason for taking the course.

2. Once you apply, you will receive an SIS ID number which allows you access to the Student Information System (SIS). You can use the SIS system to register, pay tuition and view and print final grades.
3. Register for the applicable RAD courses. The course sections and numbers can be found at: <http://www.tcc.edu/schedule/>
4. If you require **clinical** education register for **RAD 196** which will provide student liability insurance and arrange a clinical rotation through an affiliated clinical facility. RAD 196 will require 10-15 hours a week of clinical study.
5. **Submit completed application** to Ellyn Hodgis by **July 1** VA Beach Campus, Regional Health Professions Center, Room MN 107 or mailbox in Room MN 105, or mail to: 1700 College Cres., VA Beach, VA 23453 or Fax to 757-822-7570
