TCC Scholarships: A limited number of scholarships are available for qualified students who are accepted to the Ireland program and are registered for credit. Funds are limited, so please apply early. **Scholarship application deadline is February 1, 2010.**

Study Abroad Scholarship Eligibility:

- Be accepted into a TCC faculty-led overseas program.
- Be enrolled at least half time **and** have completed at least nine curricular (non developmental) credits at TCC at the time of application.
- Enroll in the course associated with this program.
- Have a GPA of at least 2.5 or higher.

Deposit: \$700 deposit due with application. Payment schedule:
Pmt 1: \$700 due 2/22/2010; Pmt 2: \$500 due 3/19/2010; Final Pmt: \$262 due 4/19/2010.

Payments must be made to the International Programs office at the Virginia Beach campus in the form of a check, money order, or credit card. (checks made payable to TCC.)
