- Must submit a complete scholarship application that includes 3 letters of recommendation.
- Be enrolled at least half time **and** have completed at least nine curricular (non developmental) credits at TCC at the time of application.
- Have a GPA of at least 2.5 or higher.
- Must be registered for courses associated with this program.

Payment Schedule*: A deposit of **\$1545** is required with a completed program application.

The final payment of **\$1545 due on December 01, 2009**.
