Study Abroad Scholarship Eligibility:

- Be accepted into a TCC faculty-led overseas program.
- Be enrolled at least half time **and** have completed at least nine curricular (non developmental) credits at TCC at the time of application.
- Enroll in the course associated with this program.
- Have a GPA of at least 2.5 or higher.

Deposit: \$700.00 deposit due with application. Payment schedule: Pmt 1: \$550 due 2/01/2011; Pmt 2: \$550 due 3/01/2011; final pmt \$550 due 4/1/2011.
