

Two Year College Transfer Grant Program

The Two Year College Grant Program was created by the General Assembly in 2007 to provide financial assistance to eligible students who transfer with an associate's degree to a Virginia four-year institution. The program is based on student need, merit, and enrollment eligibility requirements, and applies to first time freshmen entering a two-year college beginning in the fall of 2007. Eligible students can begin receiving awards in 2009.

Financially needy students who complete the associate's degree and meet GPA requirements can be considered for a \$1000 grant at a Virginia participating four-year college or university. To maintain eligibility for up to three years, students must maintain need and GPA requirements. Students enrolled in engineering, mathematics, nursing, teaching, and science programs can qualify for an additional \$1000 per year.
