

Inventor 11 Problem with Adding/Editing Text

David Ekker (TCC EGR instructor) sent me the following message:

One of my students got a copy of the Inventor 11 software when he purchased his book. He ended up calling Autodesk and turned out he had a corrupt copy. He swapped the book, and that one was also corrupt. They ended up over-nighting a copy to him. They wanted to charge him \$65 for the service call, but he argued his way out of it.

It also turns out that the discs were marked Inventor 11 SP-2, but still required to install SP-1 and SP-2, also the hot fix for editing text. This hot fix is the #2 hot fix on the Autodesk website for Inventor Professional. Without it, you cannot add text to an Inventor part or drawing.

Note, they need to have Inventor 11 SP-1 and SP-2 installed for the hot fix to be installed.
