

Fast Facts



Age Requirements:

All volunteers must be at least 16 years of age. All volunteers under the age of 19 must bring ID that verifies age and identity.

Identification will be checked each time you volunteer. No Associates of Paramount Parks Inc. may participate.

Donation:

- *Each group volunteer will receive a donation of \$6 per hour volunteered.
- *If a group member completes his whole shift, an additional \$30 will be added Sundays through Fridays, and an additional \$20 on Saturdays.
- *All individual donations are combined and one check is issued to the organization.
- *If a group fulfills its commitment to their confirmed number of volunteers, an EXTRA donation is available, as follows:
 - **If a group confirms between 5 and 10 volunteers and brings 100% of their confirmed number, an additional \$50 will be donated to the group.
 - **If a group confirms between 11 and 14 volunteers and brings 100% of their confirmed number, an additional \$100 will be donated to the group.
 - **If a group confirms between 15 and 20 volunteers and brings 100% of their confirmed number, an additional \$150 will be donated to the group.

Tickets:

Groups will receive one free ticket to Paramount's Kings Dominion for each group volunteer that completes his shift. Complimentary tickets may not be used on all public operating days. Please read your ticket for redemption information.

Before the Shift:

Report to Human Resources 30 minutes before the start of the shift to process a small amount of paperwork. Be ready to volunteer when you arrive!

Where can we Volunteer?

- * **Pavilion:** Serving food, drinks, and other catering duties in our outside shelters. Some cleaning and dishwashing.
- * **Food Service:** Preparing and serving food and drinks, guest relations, cashiering, cleaning and dishwashing. Includes inside and outside locations.
- * **Games:** Cash handling, microphone & booth operation responsibilities. Most are open-air stands.
- * **Merchandise:** Help run one of our shops while guest-relating in a friendly manner. May involve stocking, operating a cash register, counting inventory, and selling novelty items.

Appearance Standards

"Pride in our appearance at Paramount Parks is part of our Core Beliefs."

Shirts/Blouses: Solid white or solid blue polo-type, or oxford style shirt. Absolutely **no** t-shirts, sleeveless shirts, crop tops, mesh or silk screened shirts or logos.

Pants/Shorts: Solid tan, black, or navy. **No jeans!** Shorts must reach below your fingertips with arms extended at your side.

Shoes: Comfortable, closed-foot shoes such as tennis or gym shoes, in mostly white or black. **No flip-flops, sandals, open toed shoes, or slide-on's.**

Socks: If wearing shorts, volunteers must wear white socks.

Sunglasses: Are suggested in outdoor areas to improve vision and protect your eyes. Styles must be conservative.

Hats/Coats: **Only hats issued by PKD are permitted.** Scarves, bandanas, "do rags", or knit hats are **not permitted.** Solid colored raincoats or jackets may be worn during inclement weather. If the weather is cold and rainy, please wear appropriate attire as volunteers may be assigned to an outside location. Volunteers assigned to certain departments will be provided with aprons.

Hair: Should be neat, clean, natural in color, and well groomed. Ribbons and barrettes are permitted only if necessary to secure the hair. Other ornaments, beads, or bows are not permitted. Hair must be combed above the eyebrows and hair length must be evenly proportioned on all sides. Men's hair must be above the top of a shirt collar in the back. Only one part is permitted and no shaved designs and words are permitted. Spikes, dreadlocks, ponytails or Mohawks are not permitted.

Sideburns: Should be neatly trimmed and should not extend below the earlobe.

Facial Hair, Beards & Goatees: **Are not permitted.** Existing moustaches are acceptable provided they do not extend beyond the corner of the mouth. Volunteers are expected to be **clean shaven** upon arrival to PKD.

Personal Devices: Portable radios, stereos, headsets, cell phones, and laser pointers are not permitted. Cell phones shouldn't be used in view of Park guests and should not be used during the volunteer shift. Please leave all personal items and valuables at home.

Jewelry & Colognes: Jewelry should be kept to a minimum. Visible body piercings, including but not limited to nose, lip, tongue, and eyebrow piercings are **not permitted.** You may wear earrings provided they are no larger than a quarter. Dangling earrings are not permitted. Any tattoos that may be considered offensive must be covered. Please refrain from wearing excessive colognes.

****Volunteers who do not meet all appearance standards will not be able to volunteer.**

Those individuals who are unable to volunteer can pay to enter the park for the day, but are not permitted to wait for their group in the Human Resources Office. Those individuals will not be credited towards the group's final numbers.
