

## 2008-2009 F-1 ADMISSION CHECKLIST

The documents listed below are required for admission to Tidewater Community College pursuant to an I-20. All forms and documents submitted become the property of the College and must be received by the International Student Services office at the Virginia Beach Campus for review of admissibility no later than the application deadline on the back of this form. **Late applications or documents will be accepted for the next available semester.** Please read the requirements listed below very carefully.

➤ **ALL DOCUMENTS SUBMITTED MUST BE ORIGINAL. FAXED OR COPIES OF DOCUMENTS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**

❑ **TIDEWATER COMMUNITY COLLEGE APPLICATION AND I-20 APPLICATION FORM**

The TCC application must be completed and signed by the applicant. The I-20 application form (in PDF format) is located on the ISS webpage. [http://www.tcc.edu/students/ISS/F1\\_new/admissions.htm](http://www.tcc.edu/students/ISS/F1_new/admissions.htm) Indicate your dependents and complete the required information. Admission deadlines apply (see reverse side of this form).

❑ **F-1 FINANCIAL STATEMENT (All financial documents must be original and submitted in English and USD)**

You must provide evidence of the guaranteed financial support of a sponsor to cover all your school, living and personal expenses and health insurance while studying at TCC. The F1 financial statement must be current (no more than 6 months old). Financial support must indicate a sponsor's liquid assets. Retirement Accounts (IRA's) or retirement CD's are not accepted evidence of liquid assets. Open lines of credit are not accepted as a financial resource. To complete this form, follow the instructions below:

**SECTION I: IDENTIFICATION OF FUNDS:** Completed by applicant. **Be sure to print your name exactly as it is printed in your passport. If you are providing some your own funds, in addition to sponsor's funds, you must submit an additional Section 3 (Bank Verification) signed your bank official.** You are required to provide evidence of additional financial support for dependents.

**SECTION 2: AFFIDAVIT OF SUPPORT:** Completed and signed by your sponsor. If you have more than one sponsor, each sponsor must complete and sign this section to indicate their share of financial support for your studies at TCC.

**SECTION 3: VERIFICATION OF FUNDS:** This section must be completed, signed and sealed by your sponsor's bank official. \*If your bank official will not complete this section, you may submit a separate, official bank letter in English and U.S. dollars. Banks letters must indicate a specific dollar amount available and the sponsor's account number. Generic letters are not accepted. Bank documents in a foreign language will NOT be accepted. **Unacceptable or incomplete documents will delay your admission to TCC.**

❑ **TOEFL REPORT/ ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY (TCC Institutional TOEFL Code: 5787)**

Applicants from outside the United States must submit a recent, original TOEFL report sent directly from TOEFL to TCC to demonstrate English proficiency. Hand carried TOEFL reports cannot be accepted. **A minimum TOEFL score of 133 (computer based) ,450 (paper test) or 45 (Internet Based) is required for admission to TCC and the one year ESL Program.** Applicants with a current, original TOEFL score of 173 (CB), 500 (PB) or 61 (IB) are eligible for a 3 year I-20 for curricular studies. When sitting for the TOEFL test, give the test administrator TCC's TOEFL code: **5787**.

**VISA HOLDERS SEEKING A CHANGE OF STATUS TO F1 WITHIN THE UNITED STATES:** Applicants seeking a change of status to F1 and admission to TCC pursuant to an I-20 must submit a TOEFL score of 133/45, or achieve the **ESL Intermediate II level** on the Compass ESL test to be accepted into the ESL Program.

❑ **DOCUMENTATION OF COMPLETION OF SECONDARY STUDIES ( Must include an official English translation)**

F1 applicants must be 18 years of age and provide documentation of completion of secondary studies (high school) equivalent to a U.S. diploma. Applicants who have NOT completed secondary studies will not be admitted to TCC for Curricular Studies or into the English Language Program.

**F-1 TRANSFER STUDENTS SUBMIT THE ADDITIONAL REQUIRED DOCUMENTS LISTED BELOW:**

❑ **F-1 TRANSFER CLEARANCE FORM:** Required from applicants who are already in the United States in F1 status and who seek to transfer to TCC. This form must be signed by your current Foreign Student Advisor and mailed to the International Student Services office. **A hand carried original or copied document will not be accepted.**

❑ **COPY OF CURRENT I-20 FORM, VALID PASSPORT, F-1 VISA AND CURRENT I-94.**

❑ **HEALTH INSURANCE:** F1 students and their dependents are required to provide proof of health insurance coverage for each semester by the last day of the drop/add period. Proof of international student health insurance is mandatory.

❑ **TOEFL REPORT AND TRANSCRIPTS FROM CURRENT INSTITUTION: F1 transfer students must** submit official transcripts from current institution as part of admission documents. *For admission to the ESL program, transfer students must submit a current, original TOEFL report with a score of 133/450/45, or achieve the ESL Intermediate II LEVEL on the Compass ESL test.* A TOEFL score of 173/500/61 is required for admission to a curricular program.

## DEADLINES AND OTHER REQUIREMENTS

Listed below are the deadline dates for submission of documents in application for admission to TCC pursuant to an I-20. All paperwork must be completed and received by the following dates. **These deadlines will not be waived.** Late submission of documents will be accepted for the following semester. ### **2008-2009 DEADLINES FOR F1 TRANSFER STUDENTS ALREADY STUDYING IN THE U.S.**

**F1 Transfer Students often ask:** “How long can I wait between ending classes at my current school (transfer-out) and starting classes at TCC (transfer-in school)?”

- **You must begin classes at TCC at the next available term within 5 months of your transfer release date OR program completion date at your transfer-out school (whichever date is earlier). If the next available term does not begin within 5 months of your transfer release date or your program completion date at your previous school, you must depart the U.S. and re-enter the country in initial status to begin your new program.**

If you have been issued an I-20 from Tidewater Community College and you decide not to study in the U.S., you are required to return your I-20 to the International Student Services office. The address is listed below.

- F1 students must be enrolled full time each Fall and Spring semester. Curricular and ESL students must enroll for a minimum of 12 credit hours. Summer enrollment is optional, but cannot be used in place of a fall or spring enrollment. *\*Students who enter TCC in initial status or who transfer to TCC during the summer session must be enrolled full time during the summer session, **and** the following fall and spring semesters. You will not be eligible for a vacation until the following summer.*
- **F1 Transfer Students:** If your admission to TCC has been approved and your SEVIS record is released to TCC, you must report to the International Student Services office no later than 15 days after the semester begins to complete your transfer.

**FOREIGN TRANSCRIPTS:** TCC does not evaluate foreign transcripts for transfer credit. #### **\*\*SEVIS I-901 Fee**

Those seeking to enter the United States in F1 status with a Form I-20 or those seeking a change of status to F1 within the U.S. must pay a SEVIS fee before going to the US embassy or submitting documents to the Vermont Service Center.
