Nonpayment of tuition will result in cancellation of your enrollment without notification. Your enrollment is not complete until your tuition and applicable fees are paid in full.

Last day to drop for a tuition refund for a 10-week course is May 28, 2009. **Dynamic session dates may vary. See your advisor or enrollment services for more information about dynamic session deadlines.

May 23	Last day to add or change for a Ten-Week Course
May 25	Memorial Day (College Closed)
May 28	Last day to drop for tuition refund for a Ten-Week Course
June 30	Last day to withdraw without academic penalty from a Ten-Week Course (See Note)
July 3	Independence Day Holiday (College Closed - Classes made up July 28)
July 28	Last Day of Instruction (Includes Examinations) Tuesday, July 28, is the make-up day for Friday, July 3, and represents the final Friday of the Summer 10-week session.

Dynamic Session Classes have unique refund and withdrawal dates. Please contact the Enrollment Services Office for procedures and dates.

Note: Students who wish to withdraw without academic penalty should contact a counselor to determine the appropriate procedure and date. Withdrawals or drops which occur after the add/change date, through completion of sixty percent of a session, will result in a W grade. After sixty percent of a session is completed, a withdrawal (Drop) will result in a grade of F in a credit course, or a grade of U in a developmental course, except under mitigating circumstances which must be documented by the instructor and approved by the division chair.
