

MLA Works Cited

When creating a works cited page, make sure you double space the entries and indent the second or third subsequent lines ten spaces. In addition, all of the entries should be listed in alphabetical order. The selected cited materials below are the more common types of sources that need citing. If the type of source that you are trying to cite is not shown, refer to a more in-depth reference book.

Books

With one author
