

OTHER SCHOLARSHIPS

These scholarship opportunities are available through organizations outside of TCC, or are made available through programs at the college other than the Educational Foundation. Many of these scholarships have their own application process and deadlines, so be sure to read each one carefully.

Brown v. Board of Education Scholarship

The Brown v. Board of Education Scholarship Program was created by the Virginia General Assembly in 2004 as a result of the 50th anniversary of the landmark Brown decision. A legislative committee, composed of members of the Virginia House of Delegates, the Senate of Virginia, and nonlegislative citizen members appointed by the governor, is responsible for selecting eligible domiciled residents of Virginia for awards each year to attend approved educational programs in the Commonwealth. Eligible Virginians are persons who were unable to attend public school between 1954 and 1964 due to the closing of public schools in certain localities to avoid desegregation (Massive Resistance).
