# 2000 Employer Survey Study

## INTRODUCTION

As part of Tidewater Community College's on-going assessment of its academic programs, an employer survey is conducted biennially as a follow-up to the TCC Graduate Survey. Employer feedback is the foundation upon which academic programs, particularly those in the occupational/technical area, are gauged for currency and overall effectiveness.

The most recent employer survey was conducted in spring 2001 and surveyed the employers of TCC's graduating class of 2000. The survey instrument is designed to investigate graduates' skills and professional behaviors as viewed by their employers. The survey also asks employers to rate TCC with respect to how well it provides occupational/technical training and general education programs. Finally, employers rate the overall job performance of each graduate and indicate intentions of hiring other TCC graduates from the same program.

## METHODOLOGY

The employer survey sample was derived from year 2000 graduate survey respondents who consented to have their employers contacted. While this process might lend itself to sample bias, the graduates' consent is necessary to ensure their right to privacy. Two hundred ninety-six graduates (50%), out of 597 graduate respondents who were employed, gave their permission for employer contact.

The survey process included two mailings, each consisting of a letter, questionnaire, and pre-paid business reply envelope. The first mailing was completed in February 2001, approximately ten months after graduation. The second mailing was completed one month later. Overall, 166 surveys were completed and returned, resulting in a 56% response rate.

This report analyzes the data results of the 2000 survey, and where appropriate, makes comparisons with the 1998 study. In addition, Appendices A through C provide the survey instrument, employers' suggestions for improvement in educational preparation, and a listing of employer respondents by curriculum.

## **REPRESENTATION**

Due to the requirement for graduate permission to contact employers, there is the possibility of self-selection sample bias. This should be taken into account in data analysis and generalizing to the population. However, every effort has been made by the researchers to minimize these effects when and where possible.

It appears that the employer survey is heavily weighted with those students who received occupational/technical degrees or certificates (AAS, certificate, diploma.) In comparing the ratios of graduates with college transfer degrees (AA, AS) who completed the graduate survey with those who were evaluated by their employer we see a wide difference. Thirty-four percent of the employees evaluated were college transfer graduates compared to 48% of graduates who responded to the graduate survey. On the other hand, the employer survey is populated with 66% of those students who received occupational/technical degrees or certificates. This is higher than 52% of those that responded to the graduate survey having received occupational/technical degrees or certificates. This heavy weighting of occupational/technical degree and certificate graduates in the employer survey can be explained in part by the large percentage of college transfer degree students who continue their education at four-year institutions as opposed to the large number of occupational/technical graduates who enter into full-time employment.

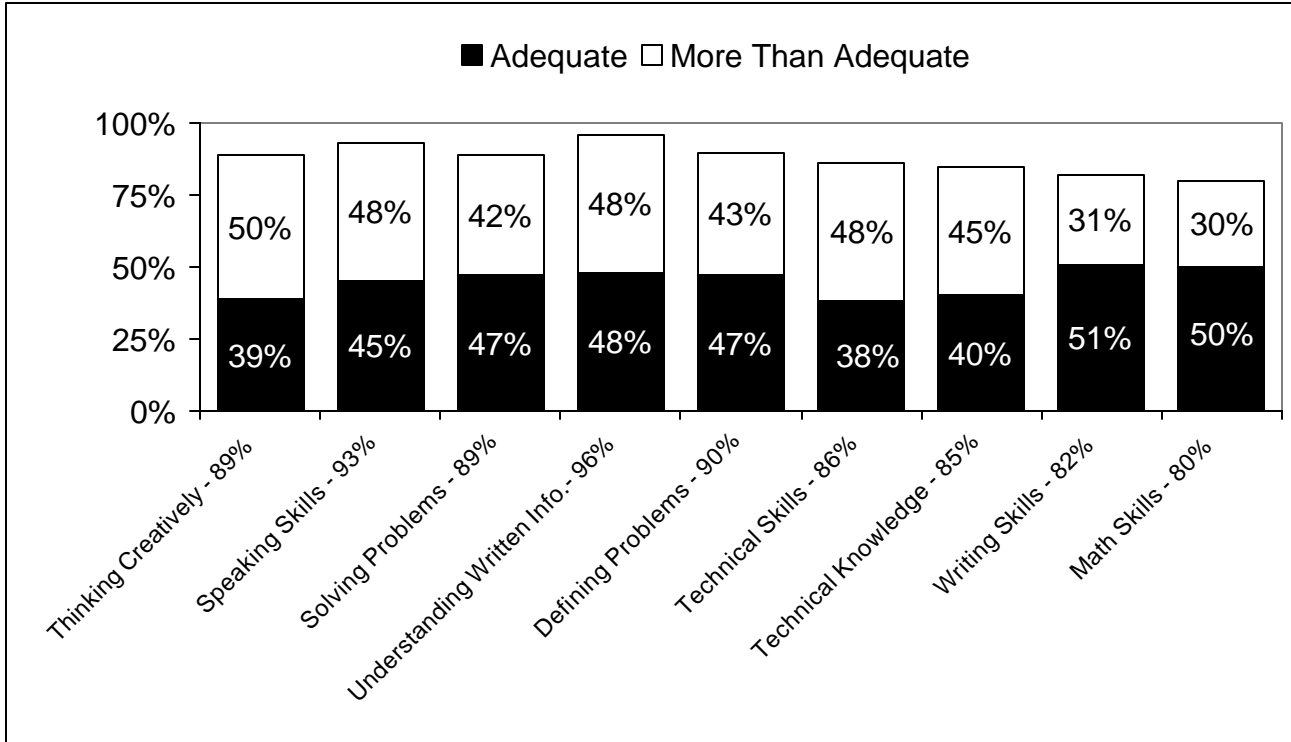
Graduates evaluated by employers were 63% female, which is slightly higher than the graduate survey response rate of 56% female. Additionally, 82% of the graduates represented in the Employer Survey were employed full time.

## **EVALUATION OF KNOWLEDGE AND SKILLS**

Employers of 2000 graduates indicated that TCC training prepared graduates either adequately, or more than adequately, in nine areas of knowledge and skills. Figure 1 illustrates that the percentages range from 80% to 96% across the nine areas. Understanding written information was rated the highest (96% more than adequate or adequate), and showed an improvement over 1998's rating of 88%. Among the remaining eight categories there was little change from 1998. Math skills (80%) continued to be the lowest rated area, although there was slight improvement over 1998 (77%).

When examined by degree type, college transfer graduates rated highest in understanding written information and speaking skills (97% and 94%, respectively), both of

which showed small increases over 1998 results. Likewise, occupational/technical graduates rated highest in understanding written information (95%), and speaking skills (91%).

Employers generally did not feel improvement was needed in any of the knowledge and skills areas. When improvement was suggested, the areas most often cited were technical skills (6%), writing skills (6%), solving problems (6%), and thinking creatively (6%). These responses are comparable to 1998 results. Many of the employers' comments relating to improvement cited the need for improved computer skills and access.

### EVALUATION OF PROFESSIONAL BEHAVIORS

Employers were overwhelmingly satisfied with graduates' professional behaviors in terms of cooperation with others, initiative, dependability, and decision-making skills. Table 1 shows satisfactory ratings ranging from 91% to 98% for each area mentioned above. The area most often cited for "needs improvement" was decision-making skills (6%). Again, these ratings are comparable to 1998 results.

### **EVALUATION OF OCCUPATIONAL/TECHNICAL TRAINING AND GENERAL EDUCATION**

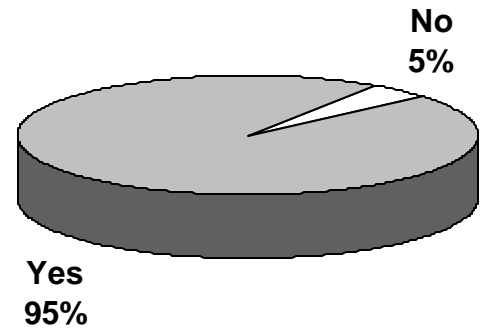
In addition to evaluating job skills and professional behaviors, employers were asked to evaluate their overall perception of occupational/technical training and general education. Results are illustrated in Table 2. Of those who expressed an opinion, occupational/technical training was rated excellent or good by 93% of the respondents (51% excellent, 42% good). General education was rated excellent or good by 91% of the respondents (46% excellent, 45% good). These response ratings are comparable to 1998 responses.

## OVERALL RATINGS OF JOB PERFORMANCE

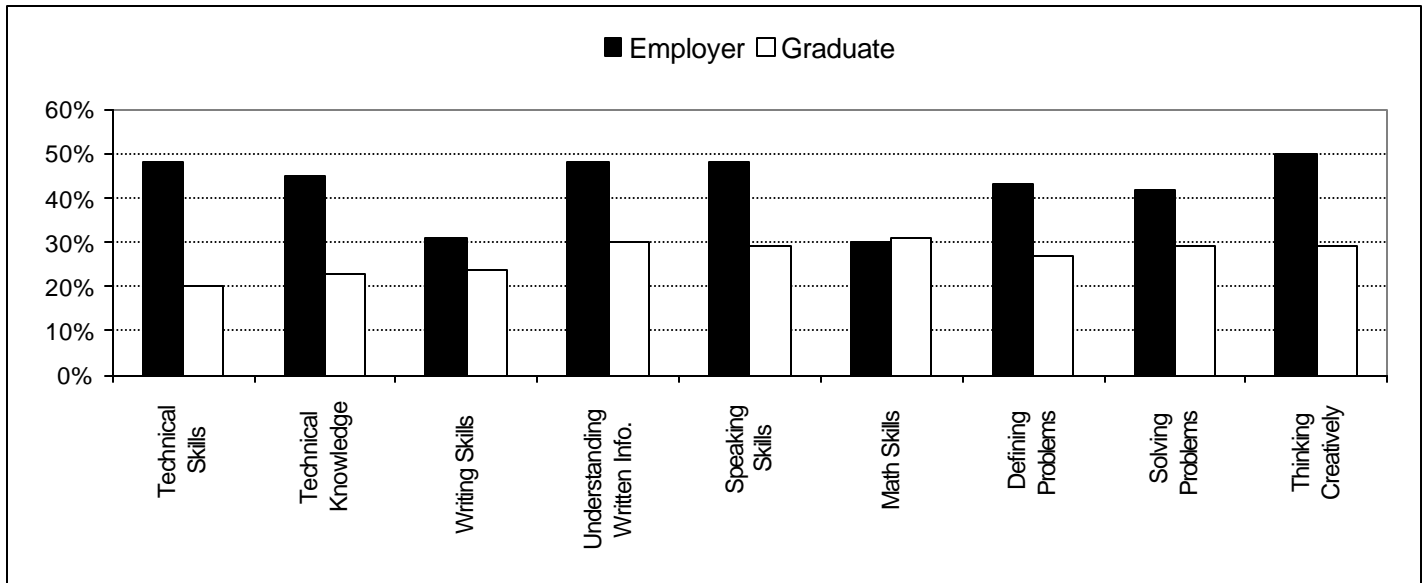
Ninety-four percent of employers rated overall job performance of TCC graduates as either excellent (59%) or good (35%). This is an improvement over the 1998 rating of 89%. Between graduates of college transfer programs and occupational/ technical programs, there was very little difference in the ratings. Moreover, a large majority (95%) of employers indicated they would employ TCC graduates from the same program if appropriate positions were available, as shown in Figure 2.



**Figure 2** Percent of Employers Who Would Hire TCC Graduate

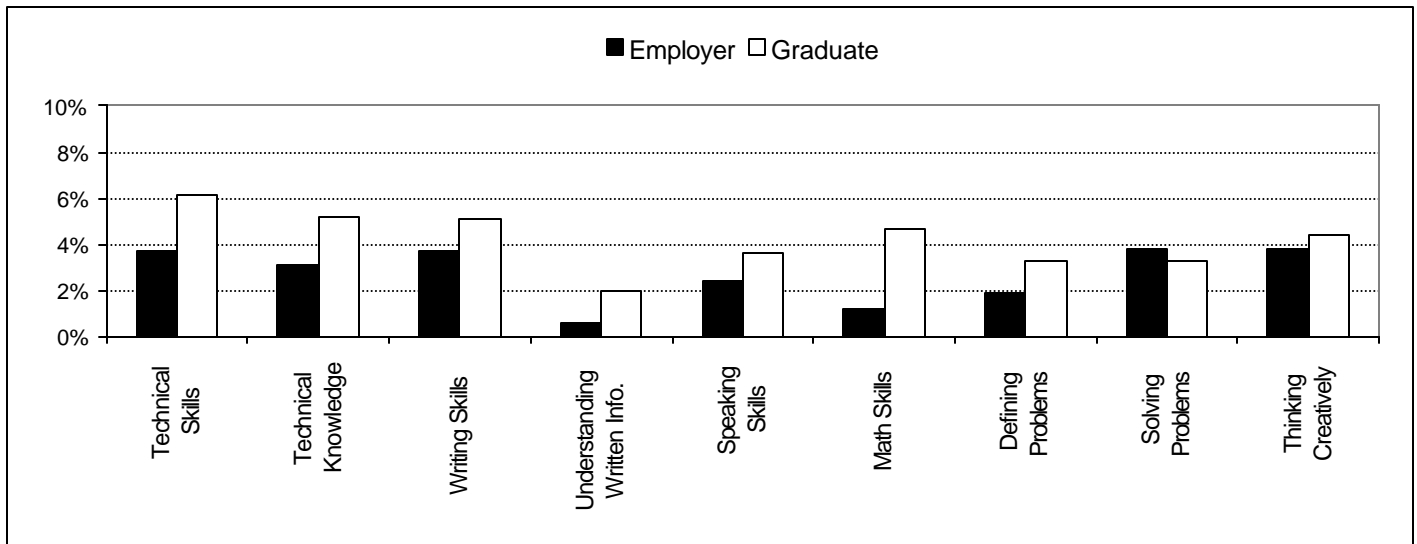
## COMPARISON OF EMPLOYER RATINGS WITH GRADUATE RATINGS

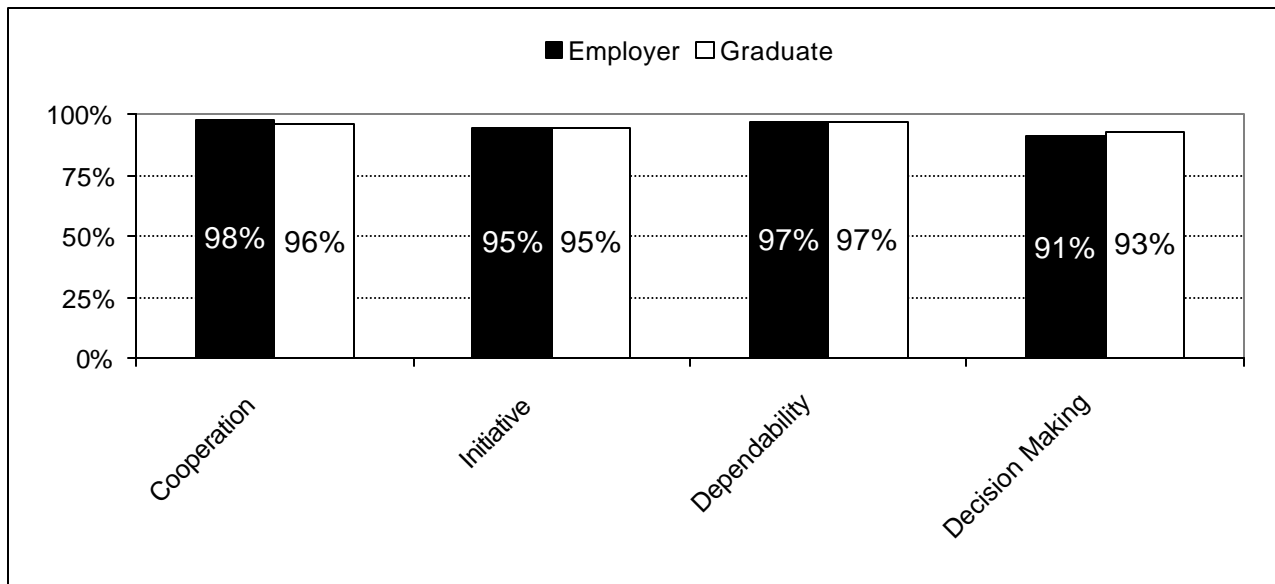
**FIGURE 3** Employer and Graduate Rating Comparisons of Knowledge and Skills for the “More Than Adequately Prepared” Category

The TCC Graduate Survey asks the graduates to rate their preparation in the same knowledge and skill areas as those listed on the TCC Employer Survey. Historically, employers tend to rate knowledge and skill areas of TCC graduates higher than the graduates. For the most part the same held true for the 2000 Employer Survey, with one exception. With regard to math skills, employers and graduates both tended to have similar ratings for “more than adequately” prepared (30% and 31%, respectively). All other categories remained consistent with 1998 results. Areas with the greatest gap in perception between employers and graduates are technical skills, technical knowledge, and thinking creatively, with employers perceiving greater ability than the graduates. Possible explanations for the perception differences include lack of self-confidence or lack of experience on the part of the graduate. The disparities in perception are depicted graphically in Figure 3.

Less than four percent of the employers targeted any one area of knowledge and skills for improvement. As can be seen in Figure 4, graduates were much more likely to feel a need for improvement in the knowledge and skill areas as compared to employers. In fact, in only one area, solving problems, did employers cite a need for improvement more frequently than graduates. These response rates are similar to 1998 rates. Results are depicted in Figure 4.

With respect to professional behaviors, both employers and graduates have nearly identical views on cooperation, initiative, dependability, and decision making, giving adequate ratings between 91% and 98%. These results are provided graphically in Figure 5.

## CONCLUSION

This employer survey overwhelmingly supports the quality education offered by TCC. For those respondents who expressed an opinion, over 90% of the employers rated TCC's general education and occupational/technical training components as good to excellent. Further proof of employer satisfaction is the fact that 95% of the employers indicated they would hire a TCC graduate from the same program if an appropriate position became available.

Overall, employers were satisfied with the preparation of the TCC graduates in terms of knowledge, skills, and professional behaviors. This is echoed by the comments of one employer who stated, “... I can testify to the excellent level of education received at any of Tidewater Community College’s campuses... skills, attitude, and work ethic reinforce the fact that TCC students are a good investment for any employer.”
