RE: Student Conduct

On November 1, 2007 the College Faculty Senate approved the statement that “the Faculty Senate request that a committee of faculty, students, and administrators, be formed by Dr. Summers by the end of the fall semester 2007 to create college wide policies and procedures which addresses student conduct”

Based on the information the Senate received regarding the handling of a disrupted student, Faculty do not believe that the current policies of the College provide adequate guidance to students on the expectations of the College of their conduct on campus nor to Faculty on the procedure to handle disruptive students. The College Senate believes that developing policies that protect the rights of students and faculty members should be a priority of the College.
