- II. Chair Report (Dave Ring)
  - a. Academic Affairs Meeting Spring 2022 enrollment was down with head count up. Preliminary indication of enrollment is trending up for Summer 2022 and Fall 2022.
  - b. Title 3 Grant Dr. Summers stated that Faculty Advising will be implemented for the Fall 2022 semester beginning with CTE Programs. There will be 4 Faculty Trainers who will receive instruction Summer 2022. Eric Hayes will represent Chesapeake. A list of the 57 faculty advisors for Fall 2022 has not been provided. Faculty will receive a stipend of \$750.
