 - (1) Given the late stage of schedule development, faculty senate move that the administration delay the requirement for full-time faculty to teach a specific number of classes face-to-face until a comprehensive scheduling plan based on meaningful campus and program specific date is developed.
 - (2) Given the late stage of schedule development, faculty senate move that administration supply the rationale for requiring full-time faculty to teach a specific number of classes face-to-face considering the impact on specific programs, impact on adjunct faculty retention, impact on compressed sessions, impact on diversity of course offerings, impact on the ability to offer zerocost courses, and impact on student retention.
 - Although there wasn't a vote, the consensus was that VB Senate generally supported these based on the principle of 'shared governance'.
