The meeting began with an introduction by the new chair of the Chesapeake Faculty Senate Rianna Amolsch, who welcomed the group and called to order the regular meeting of the Chesapeake Faculty Senate.

Next, Rianna Amolsch moved to new business:

- Amolsch mentioned that the college-wide Faculty Senate meeting would be held on September 3, 2015 on the Chesapeake campus
- The group discussed the newly revised Faculty Development and Evaluation Plan (Is the e-portfolio mandatory?)
- It was noted that there was some concern among the faculty members at the Chesapeake campus due to the college's low student enrollment, which led to the canceling of several sections of classes in the Humanities and Social Sciences Division
- With low student enrollment and classes being canceled, Ian Bolling discussed whether full-time faculty members could bump adjuncts for classes, including ones for overloads
- The group also discussed concerns with online instruction (online course caps)
- Additionally, LaCroix encouraged faculty members to be involved (pro-active) with the administration's process of developing and creating policies at TCC

The meeting was then adjourned.
