- 1. Sarah circulated the City of Norfolk plan for the redevelopment of the St. Paul corridor. This included the plans for the TCC Center for Visual and Culinary Arts.
- 2. Sarah reported on the BTW tech training plan.
- 3. Sarah reported on the Norfolk Tax Inc. effort for education and poverty reduction.
