 - A. Bob Maynard has asked for help/guidance. Faculty would like to get some data tracking student success of the students that they have sent forward from each class as they build upon each subsequent course/module. At present they have NO idea as to the success or failure of their courses. Regina Barnet has volunteered to ask Curt Aasen for help in this, and Jim Roberts is going to address this issue with the College Senate to see if they are interested in this type of reporting. If so, then we could invite Curt Aasen or his delegate to visit the next College Senate meeting in Norfolk (October meeting)

 - **A.** In the past, the Workforce Development Department has provided student vouchers for students to take certification exams. With the new director of WFD, Dr. Corey McCray, the student voucher program has been abandoned, making it incumbent upon the student to pay 100% of the certification exam, where with the student voucher, this has saved the student at least 50%. This is impacting TCC with decreased enrollment as the students are going to institutions that are providing the vouchers.
