- I. Call to Order by Chair Jim Roberts at 12:32 PM
- II. Review/Approval of October 29, 2015 Minutes as amended, accepted at 12:37 PM.
- **III.** Chair Report: The need for policy input is NOW (textbook selection & course scheduling).
  - A. Areas for policy input by faculty
    - 1. Textbook selection
    - 2. Course Scheduling
    - 3. There was serious discussion on the upcoming Pathways Initiative (Article V.D), of note, the concept of "stackable credits."
      - a) This evolved into the number of credits for degrees vs. certificates
      - b) The degree requirements are established and maintained by SCHEV and unable to be modified by individual institutions.

## IV. Old Business:

#### A. FDEP

- 1. Last meeting two Fridays ago (October 16)
  - a) What is the status of dean training for standardization in regards to the FDEP?
  - b) Changes have been made to the existing ePortfolio and there now exist notes on each of the elements
  - c) Administrative touchpoint is now VP Fred Stemple and VP John Morea
  - d) Moving these elements forward is hampered by the difference of types of years, i.e. calendar (Jan Dec) vs. actual (Oct Sep)
  - e) For current faculty under FDEP evaluation, new extended submission deadline is now November  $2^{na}$ .
    - i. Deans are attempting to receive specific guidance from Dr. DeMarte
  - f) It is the Virginia Beach Faculty Senate recommendation that the deans read the FDEP for guidance.

- B. Computer Competency requirement suspended
  - 1. This is NO LONGER a graduation requirement
  - 2. Discussion needs to transpire between faculty and Dr. DeMarte to establish clear cut distinction in regards to graduate expectations regarding computer competencies
- C. Institutional Effectiveness request for data
  - 1. Curt Aasen is meeting the College Faculty Senate in the November meeting in reference to this topic

#### V. New Business:

- A. Open Dialogue on Academics with Dr. DeMarte: "ownership" and "closing the loop" on certain processes (like student assessment)
- B. Mental Health support/awareness on campus
  - 1. Monica McFerrin (CFS Chair) is going to request the College Faculty Senate to approve expenses for luncheon meeting one each campus between faculty and Dr. Jessica Smith and/or Dr. Lawrence Smith,
- C. Faculty Promotion Policy –for approval
  - 1. Proposed Policy 3108 establishes a standing committee for College promotions.
  - 2. Understanding is that this committee is to be "appointed" by the President
    - a) Who establishes/selects the faculty membership?
- D. Pathways Initiative & Academic Restructuring
  - 1. VP Fred Stemple has the Professional Development database material necessary for this
- E. "Textbook" selection policies & procedures
  - 1. Dr. David Kiracofe (Chesapeake) is the new committee chair
  - 2. Committee is working on both a proposed policy in keeping with commonwealth laws/guidelines, and establishing a general philosophy for guidance

- 1. The Virginia Beach needs to re-evaluate distribution of senate membership due to recent reorganization of Divisions.
  - a) This was proposed for an Agenda item in January 2016 to take into account possible readjustment from the Pathways initiative.
